

Wood burning stove Firebelly FB T1, 4 kW Oxnam



Installation project

Already an established customer of Border Eco Systems our client was seeking a wood burning stove, the small Firebelly, to compliment their biomass heating and solar thermal hot water energy choices.

The living room was a blank canvas, without any hearth or chimney breast. Taking into account the position of building joists a central point was chosen to create a raised granite hearth in lieu of a fireplace, a feature made of the stove pipe which passes through the ceiling into storage space on the first floor then up into a securely mounted roof flue. For health and safety a fire board has been inserted into the lounge wall behind the stove and pipe. Similarly, the pipe and flue are safely enclosed in a fire resistant box in the house's upper floor.

- ▶ **Stove type** Firebelly FB T1 room heater maximum output 4 kW
- ▶ **Estimated refilling periods** 1-2 hourly with well seasoned wood or wood briquettes A little wood and often rather than overfill.
- ▶ **Service requirements** regularly reduce volume of ash from grate, annual stove service and flue clean
